- **5/1 - 5/25 THS:** The sophomore Biology classes from Tala-wanda High School will be visit-ing the banding stations this month.
- **5/4-6:** *Indiana Audubon An-nual Meeting* at Mary Gray Brid Sanctuary, Connersville, IN. Friday evening, famed photog-rapher Jim Chagares will give a photo presentation of the Eagle rescue at Brookville Lake last year. Dave and Jill will be giving seminars on *Birding By Ear* and *Birds Without Borders* on Saturday. **Sunday morning we will be bird banding at the Sanctuary.**
